





Second Language Services

Second Language Services provide training, resources and information to assist military families with integrating into the community and interacting with others within the same first-language community.

Second Language Training

Spring Semester April to June

This program helps interested military spouses learn English or French in a structured environment. Placement tests are mandatory for new students (\$10 for non military spouses).

- -French classes run two evenings per week
- -English classes run two mornings per week
- -\$50 for military spouses
 - (refundable upon meeting attendance criteria)
- -\$100 for other interested participants
- -Registration deadline is Thursday April 5,

Life Skills English Tutoring

April to May

This tutoring program is an informal yet structured program to help Francophone partners (only) adjust to the community. The program focuses on basic life skills such as shopping, banking, hospital visits and more. Placement tests are mandatory.
